I am writing concerning your personnel's performance in the analysis of the proficiency testing specimens that were recently sent to evaluate their capability to reliably analyze urine for drugs subject to abuse.

Based on a review of your analysts' performance, it has been determined that your laboratory can satisfactorily offer urine drug screening and confirmatory testing services to the extent specified below:

If your analysts did not perform satisfactorily, you will be afforded another opportunity to complete the authorization requirements by analyzing another set of proficiency survey specimens, which will be enclosed with this letter if necessary for repeat testing.

Your facility will be added to our list of laboratories approved to offer this service in accordance with regulations in Section 5.50 of Title 28, *Pennsylvania Code*, promulgated under the Commonwealth's Clinical Laboratory Act (35 P.S. §§2151-2165).
